







SMARTER THAN SMOKING - SENIOR SUMMER SIX A SIDE - RULES OF THE GAME - 2023

- 1. A match is played by two teams, each consisting of not more than 6 players, one of whom is the goalkeeper. Up to a maximum of four (4) interchangeable substitues may be used.
- 2. All substitutions are to take place at side of the field, near half-way line, with the consent of the Referee when the ball is out of play.
- 3. All players of a team must wear the same colour shirt, other than the goalkeeper who must wear colours which distinguish him from other players.
- 4. Studs and Blades are NOT permitted on footwear.
- 5. Matches will consist of two twenty (20) minutehalves, with straight turn around at half time. Late starts will result in halves being reduced accordingly.
- 6. Goalkeepers can **play** the ball outside of the D but can only handle the ball inside the D. Goalkeeps are allowed in the field of play.
- 7. Outfield players may play the ball inside the D.
- 8. Penalty kicks to be taken from the top of the D, central to the goal and are to be taken off no more than 2 steps. All players other than kicker and defending goalkeeper must be behind the line of the ball and at least 5 metres from it.
- 9. Ball out of play over side-line will result in a kick-in being awarded to opposing team.
- 10. For all free-kicks, kick-offs and kick-ins, opposing players must be a minimum of five (5) metres from the ball.
- 11. There is no offside.
- 12. No slide **tackles** are permitted, if opposing player is playing or attempting to play the ball.
- 13. **Two Yellow Cards** will result in a **Red Card** being shown and the the player being removed from the game. A straight **Red Card** will also incur suspension from next game.
- 14. Verbal abuse towards the referee will result in a **Yellow Card**. Physical contact that is aggressive towards the referee will result in a **Red Card** and suspension from further games under the discretion of the committee.
- 15. Other than the variations mentioned in rules 1-13, all other rules governing the game of football will apply.
- 16. No substitution will be permitted for players that have been sent off.
- 17. All refereeing decisions will be final and binding.
- 18. Where team colours clash, the team mentioned first on fixture list is required to change.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. A match card (provided by FUFC) must be completed for each fixture and handed to the referee prior to kick off.
- 2. A team failing to be ready to kick off ten (10) minutes after the scheduled kick off time will forfeit the match 3- 0.
- 3. No alcohol is to be consumed outside of the licensed area.
- 4. Forrestfield United Soccer Club does not carry insurance for this competition; therefore, participation is at the player's own risk.
- 5. Players must be six (16) years and over to be eligible to play.
- 6. FUSC Six A Side committee reserves the right to exclude any team from the competition for serious misconduct or breaches of the rules.
